

DRIVE OUT HUNGER OVERVIEW

DRIVE Out Hunger is a year-round community service initiative dedicated to raising awareness about food insecurity and inspiring meaningful action to reduce hunger locally and globally. The program empowers participants to create real impact in their communities through service, education, and outreach.

At the heart of the initiative is the **D.R.I.V.E. Mission**, which guides all service efforts:

D - Donate

Collect and provide essential items such as food and hygiene products to support families and local food assistance programs.

Examples: Host a food drive, organize donation collections at school or work, gather items for families in need.

R - Reach Others

Raise awareness and encourage others to take action against hunger.

Examples: Speak to groups, partner with organizations, and share information through social media or community events.

I - Impact Communities

Create meaningful change through hands-on service and community-based projects.

Examples: Organize service events, collaborate with nonprofits, or lead awareness campaigns.

V - Volunteer

Give time and energy to organizations that fight food insecurity.

Examples: Work at food banks or pantries, pack meal boxes, or assist community meal programs.

E - Educate

Teach others about food insecurity and how they can help make a difference.

Examples: Create presentations, share resources, or host discussions on hunger and solutions.

Through DRIVE Out Hunger, participants are encouraged to donate, reach others, volunteer, impact communities, and educate those around them. The goal is to build a culture of compassion and service while empowering individuals to take action that leads to lasting change in the fight against hunger.
